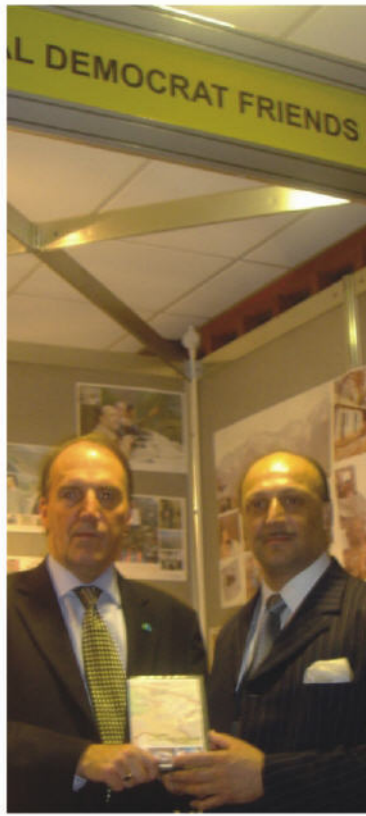


Liberal Democrats Friends of Kashmir

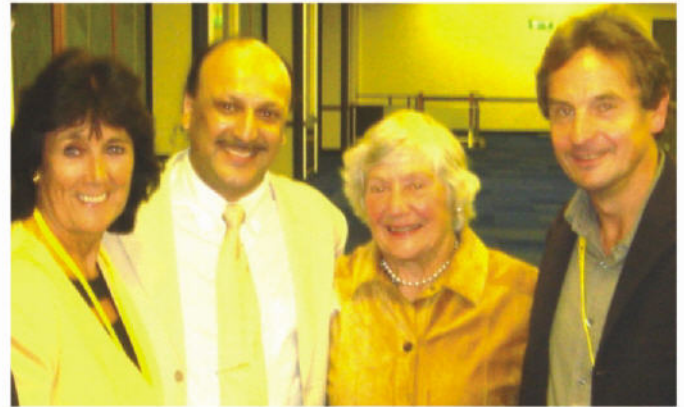
Leader Sir Minzies Campbell CBE QC MP, Visits in 2006
